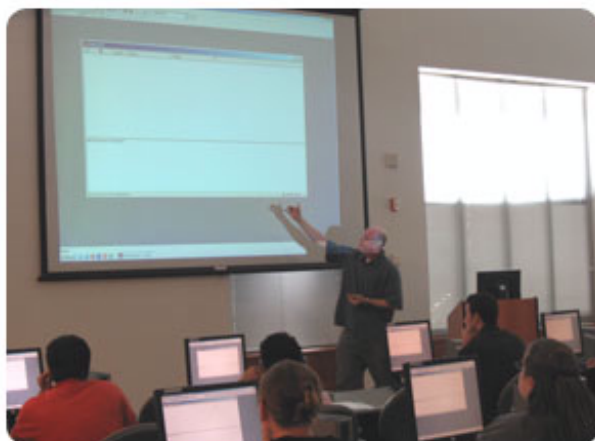


# Education and Outreach
